



Rolled Hem Dream Catcher



Requirements

2 x Rattan Rings
Organza Ribbon
2 x spools Designer Threads Decorative Thread
1 x spool polyester overlocking thread
Assorted beads (with large holes in the centre)
Assorted feathers
Baby Lock Overlocker
Hot Glue Gun


Wrap the ribbon around the rings firmly, stick the ends with a small drop of hot glue.





Set the overlocker for a three thread rolled hem, use the thread you want most visible on the upper looper. Stitch Length 2-3 rolled hem Stitch width M Stitch selector D Roll hem meters of braid, holding the end of the chain, guiding it through.


Wrap the braid around the ring, looping and securing with slip knots as you go and sliding the beads on to the braid between the loops. See pic 3





Once you have completed the entire outside of the ring, take the braid through the original loops, continue threading the beads through. Pic 4. Finish when you reach the centre of the dream catcher, finish the ends securely. See pic 5.

Repeat these steps for the smaller ring. Once the two rings are finished put the dream catcher together using the remaining braid to suspend the smaller ring from the larger ring.





Make a loop and attach it to the centre top of the large ring to hang the dream catcher.

Thread feathers and beads on to strands of braid and tie these on to the rings to finish the dream catcher.

Have fun playing with colours and different types of Designer Threads when creating these gorgeous dream catchers.
