





# Techniques

## *How To Finish Coverstitch In The Round*



- This technique applies to the Euphoria and Coverstitch Machines also the combination machines such as Gloria, Ovation, Accolade, Evolution, Evolve and Evolve Wave.
- Fold up the hem, for best results press before stitching.
- Position the hem under the coverstitch needles, using the fabric guide if needed for an accurate hem.
- Use the Clear Curve Foot (M0-36062) it's shorter than any standard foot and gives you greater visibility (pic 1)
- Begin stitching, as the start of the stitching is approaching the presser foot trim the needle threads from the start of the stitching level with the fabric (pic 2), continue stitching three or four stitches over the beginning of the stitches.
- Turning the hand wheel forward towards you, finish with the needles in the highest position, raise the presser foot and use your fingers to pull the needle threads out 2" just above the needle thread guide (pic 3)
- Then take the tweezers and pull that excess thread under the presser foot (pic 4).
- Cut the needle threads (pic 5).
- Carefully remove the work from under the presser foot, pulling towards the back of the machine, as it gets taken out of the machine the needle threads pull through to the back of the work (pic 6).
- Tie off the threads at the back to ensure the Coverstitching is secure (pic 7).
